Safeguarding Courses – April & May 2019

Safeguarding – Toxic Trio – 26th April – 9.30am – 4.30pm – Parkwood Centre, **Alfreton** Anyone involved in assessing children, young people and their families. This course focusses on the combination of Domestic Abuse, Parental Mental Health and Parental Substance Misuse and the impact this has on children and young people.

Safeguarding – Everybodys Business - 29th April – 9.30am – 4.30pm - **Erewash Hub, Ilkeston** - To promote effective 'working together' for all who work with children, young people and families in order to safeguard and promote children and young people's welfare

Safeguarding for Managers and Safeguarding Leads – 30th April – 9.30am – 4.30pm – **Masson Mill, Matlock Bath** - For those who are relatively new to role in relation to safeguarding but **must** have a lead safeguarding role. This course is applicable to those who work for Derbyshire County Council (DCC) and for those outside Derbyshire County Council.

Safeguarding – Working with Resistant Families – 2nd May – 9.30am – 12.30pm - **Denby Depot** To develop an understanding of challenge, conflict and dangerousness in safeguarding work with children and young people, with parents, carers, families and others

Safeguarding – Hidden Men – 2nd May – 1.30am – 4.30pm - **Denby Depot, near Ripley** To explore the issues around "Hidden Men"/ How do we identify "Hidden Men"

Safeguarding – Impact of Parental Substance Misuse on the Child – 8th May - 9.30am – 4.30pm - **Denby Depot, near Ripley** To develop an advanced understanding and response to children young people and families where there are complex substance use and safeguarding issues

Safeguarding – Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder – 10th May – 9.30am – 13.00pm - Denby Depot, near Ripley This course aims to increase the awareness around Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) and to look at ways to support

Safeguarding – Everybodys Business - 16th May – 9.30am – 4.30pm - Buxton Area Education Office To promote effective ‘working together’ for all who work with children, young people and families in order to safeguard and promote children and young people’s welfare

Safeguarding – Child and Adolescent Development – 17th May – 9.30am – 4.30pm - Parkwood, Alfreton The course will enable you to understand, recognise and work with child development through responding to those families affected

Safeguarding – Domestic Abuse – 20th May – 9.30am – 4.30pm - Denby Depot, near Ripley To promote an understanding of the extent and impact of Domestic Abuse on children, young people and adult victims/survivors. The day will cover what action can be taken to promote and safeguard the welfare of children and young people.

Safeguarding – Online Safety – 22nd May – 9.30am – 4.30pm - Masson Mill, Matlock Bath To provide learners with the knowledge and skills related to online safeguarding issues.

Safeguarding – CSE (Practitioners) – 24th May - 9.30am – 4.30pm The Hub, South Normanton This full day course aims to assist Practitioners to have a greater understanding of Child Sexual Exploitation and in the use of the DSCB Toolkit, associated information sharing and protocols

Safeguarding – Self Harm – 29th May – 9.30am – 4.30pm County Hall, Matlock To develop a greater understanding of self harm and suicide in children. To understand what might trigger this behaviour and how a cycle is created. To help staff understand and support children more effectively

Safeguarding – CSE (Recognising and Reporting) – 30th May 9.30am – 12.30pm – Erewash Hub, Ilkeston To assist individuals in recognising potential Child Sexual Exploitation, which they may encounter during the course of their work and to know how to report it
